

TREASURE HUNT STYLE

What Is The Treasure Hunt Style?

Treasure hunt evangelism is all about praying and asking God to reveal specific people that He'd want you to bring the message of salvation to. In short, you pray and ask God for clues, then go out looking for the people He has highlighted!

Step 1

Each student writes down the words of knowledge they receive for each category.

- Location (cafeteria, library, classroom, gym)
- A person's name
- A person's appearance (the color of their hair, skin color, height, etc)
- What God highlighted to you about them (relationship, home life, anxiety, sickness, etc)
- Any unusual words or phrases (red door, cats, chocolate bar, windmill)

Gather in groups of three or four

Note: Each member keeps their own list -- do not combine lists.

Step 2

When you come across someone that matches any of the descriptions on your list:

- Approach the person, make a personal connection. Share what you believe God showed you about them. Ask if you can pray for them.

Step 3 - If they say "yes"

- Ask for the presence of God to come, (release the power of the Holy Spirit on them).
- Many times it will have to do with a sickness or something God wants to heal. If that is the case, command the pain to leave. Release healing.
- Ask them to test it out. Rate their pain from 1-10
- Repeat if necessary

Step 4 - If they say "no"

- Build more common ground and personal connection. Invite them to come out to your youth group, give them a church invite card, etc.
- Ask The Holy Spirit for more insight, and then further explain what the Lord is revealing about them or wants to say to them. Encourage them.
- Ask again if you can pray with them... if still a no, simply bless them and move on to the next "treasure."

Step 5 - When they are Healed/Touched/Delivered

- Explain what just happened
- Ask them if they would like to receive salvation
- Lead them into salvation
- Invite them to Church/Youth group
- If they accept Jesus as their Savior: HAVE THEM TEXT "IMALIVE" TO 555888
